2. Opening and Technical Issues

• Meeting began informally with several participants joining late due to technical issues.

3. Review of Safety Procedures at Royal Southern Spring Champs

- Concern raised about lack of structured rescue process during recent event.
- Simon Potter conducting a post-event review; his findings are to be incorporated into class-wide process updates.

- Rescue procedure improvements include clarity for newer sailors, readiness of safety boat personnel and standardised rescue roles.
- Several sailors entered water with inadequate clothing, raising welfare concerns re hypothermia.
- No clear guidance exists on what constitutes 'suitable clothing'.
- Proposal to create official clothing guidance document.

5. Capsize Recovery and Rescue Training

- Jeremy reported multiple cases of sailors unable to right turtled boats.
- Ben highlighted a gap in training sailors often not taught capsize and recovery in 420s.
- Use of masthead floats discussed; stigma still present but safety benefits emphasised.
- Claire and David reported rescue difficulties due to light sailors' weight and technical issues.
- Plan to promote available RYA capsize recovery video and improve rescue crew familiarity with 420-specific recovery techniques.

6. Safety Planning for Youth Nationals

- Gareth noted that rescue leadership at Youth Nationals will be external (not class-led).
- Sharon and Graham to represent class on-site.
- Discussion about potential overcrowding if course is shared with Nacras.
- Gareth advocating for class to avoid Nacra overlap and awaiting RYA confirmation.

7. Whiskying and Race Cutoffs

- Concern over sailors sitting idle and cold between races due to wide time gaps.
- Proposal to implement earlier whiskying of trailing boats when safe.
- Discussion of specific incident: boat chose to wait for whiskying rather than retire; seen as inappropriate.
- Need for clear rules in SIs on when whiskying is allowed vs. when a boat should be timed out.

8. Nationals Planning and Social Programme

- Sailor reps suggested rough plans; awaiting costing from host club.
- Intention to hold meeting during Youth Nationals to finalise schedule.
- Claire and Kirsten coordinating with reps and club to finalise logistics and pricing.

9. Event Calendar, Budgeting and Loss Thresholds

- Concerns over sparse published calendar.
- Mark and Kirsten to confirm additional GPs and smaller local training events.

- Claire proposed framework for managing acceptable event losses, potentially subsidised by surplus training income.
- All agreed losses must be planned, not accidental.

10. Training Report and Summer Planning

- Mark reported training events have netted ~£4.5k surplus.
- Plans for summer squad for non-youth squad sailors going to Porto.
- Coaches secured: Hatty Morsley and Tim Rush.
- Plan to keep group size tight for quality and coach focus.

11. Future Venue Planning

- Brixham confirmed for Nationals 2026; awaiting costing.
- Felixstowe proposal under review; waiting for details on pricing and programme.
- Gareth noted early planning needed for 2026 and potential event/venue gaps.

12. AOB

- Reminder to update Google Sheet with all confirmed dates, including RYA squad and class training.
- General appreciation expressed for progress across safety, training and planning.
