2. Review of Previous Actions

• Sponsorship Terms (Gill Agreement):

David Davies drafted terms; David confirmed Gill requested one amendment (not being bound to provide all international kit). They are otherwise happy to proceed. David to follow up.

3. Sailor Reps Update

Rutland Inlands Social:

- o Theme: "UK Icons"
- o No room currently booked; request made to secure the John Merrick's Room.
- Discussion around food provision; likely to arrange food for Saturday evening (6:00 PM), with the social starting around 7:30–8:00 PM.
- o Sharon to contact Rutland to confirm room and catering options.
- o Sharon to coordinate with Kirsten and set up online booking/payment if needed.

Nationals Social Planning:

- Ideas include: Lingo night, fish & chips with beach games, and a black-tie evening.
- Venue: Felixstowe steep shingle beach may limit beach games; alternative spaces available (fields, boat park).
- o Kirsten to connect sailor reps with Felixstowe contacts for planning.
- Volunteers: Sarah Shepherd (youth event), Victoria Scalding, and Claire Rogers offered support.
- Gareth to arrange a planning call with sailor reps and volunteers.

Buddy System:

- o Mixed feedback; needs improvement.
- o Suggestions: structured icebreaker activities, "Pro-Am" style pairings with incentives, early-week team-building games (e.g., tug of war, beach clean).
- Sailor reps to develop a structured plan for the week, including social and buddy activities.

Social Media:

- o Positive feedback on recent improvements.
- o Ideas: On-water interviews, standard Q&A with top sailors, more reposting of sailor content.
- Jeremy to coordinate with sailor reps; possible access to Instagram and Canva templates.
- Sharon suggested encouraging a wider range of sailors to post content.

• Use of Cameras:

- Discussion on allowing onboard footage during events.
- o Ben and Steve to draft a proposal for committee review at the next meeting.
- No decision made; to be revisited.

4. RYA & External Updates

Youth Nationals Course Allocation:

- Request made to separate 420s from ILCA fleet due to safety concerns.
- o RYA is considering moving ILCA to a different course.

• RYA Academies:

- o New regional academies being launched.
- o Concerns raised about lack of clarity and increasing event costs.
- o Other classes share similar concerns.

5. Dinghy Show Feedback

- Positive feedback on the 420 stand and engagement.
- 26 people signed up for taster sessions.
- Gil provided support and branding materials.
- Opportunity to involve sailors in future shows (e.g., paid roles in activity zones).
- Many former 420 sailors visited the stand, including members of the 1977 British Women's Team.
- Potential collaboration with SailGP alumni for promotional content.
- Jeremy to draft standard interview questions for alumni video project.

6. Nationals 2026 - Felixstowe Planning

- Sharon awaiting costings from the club to finalize the budget.
- Draft programme and information booklet in progress.
- Accommodation options being compiled (tent field, campervans, local B&Bs).
- Goal: Finalize and publish event details before the next committee meeting.

• Squad Qualification Discussion:

- \circ Ollie (RYA) requested using Nationals as a squad qualifier.
- o Mixed views; concerns about fairness and timing.
- o Decision deferred; further discussion required.

7. East Coast Engagement

- Opportunities to grow fleet on East Coast (Blackwater, Burnham, Brightlingsea).
- Potential to use class boats for taster sessions or regional training.
- Sharon, Kirsten, and Jeremy to coordinate with Mark on regional outreach and training.

9. Nationals - Selection Policy Discussion

• Selection Criteria Debate:

- Concerns raised about fairness of selection policy, particularly regarding Under 17 sailors.
- Discussion around the 50% rule: boats within top 50% of the selection ladder automatically qualify.
- Debate on whether discretion should be applied to support younger sailors or those with long-term class commitment.
- Gareth confirmed wording changes to the policy to allow more flexibility and discretion.
- o Ian Walker to attend events to observe sailors and support selection decisions.
- Sharon emphasized the evolution of the policy and the effort to ensure fairness.
- Tiffany highlighted the importance of rewarding long-term commitment to the class.
- David Davies and Jeremy raised concerns about potential disadvantages for Under 17s.
- o Agreement to revisit the topic with Ian Walker at Royal Southern.

10. International Events Update

Worlds (France):

- Accommodation pre-reserved for 8 boats, coaches, and house parents.
- Awaiting confirmation on carnet requirements and ferry quotes.
- Budget remains provisional due to lack of transport cost clarity.
- Low number of expressions of interest (only 4 boats so far).
- Sharon to send reminder email and information packs to encourage sign-ups.
- Tiffany to host a parent Q&A at Rutland; Ian to host one at Royal Southern.

Europeans (Porto):

One ferry booked with cabin space.

- Potential for second trailer depending on interest.
- RYA planning to start training on 12th July (10 days before racing).
- Committee discussed pros and cons of extended training period.
- Decision: Class will likely start training around 16th–17th July, with flexibility based on interest.
- Tiffany to manage coaching logistics based on confirmed numbers.

Additional International Opportunities:

- Alice in contact with French 420 representative to explore open events.
- Potential development event in Viscaros (May half-term) discussed.
- German boats interested in attending UK Nationals; Sharon to prepare booklet for international visitors.

11. Upcoming Events

Rutland Inlands:

- 25 boats entered.
- Volunteer sheet populated; minor gaps to be filled.
- PRO confirmed for Saturday; alternate PRO for Sunday due to personal circumstances.
- Jury confirmed.
- Sharon and Kirsten coordinating logistics and budget.

- Event open; 3 entries so far.
- David coordinating logistics; PRO and committee boat confirmed.
- Proposal for Saturday night food and potential speaker (e.g., Twiggy or Ian Walker).
- Club happy to allow boats to remain on site between training and event weekends.

12. Selection Policy Communication

- Parents Q&A sessions planned to clarify selection and event logistics.

13. Additional Event Planning

Mini GP at Poole Yacht Club:

- Committee agreed to proceed; Kirsten to confirm with Poole.

End of Season Events – Grafham:

- Dates confirmed: 15th and 22nd November.
- Option to revert to original dates (8th and 15th) offered by ILCA.
- Committee agreed to revert to original dates for better sailing conditions.

Nationals 2026 and Beyond:

- Kirsten initiating venue search.
- Paignton and Brixham approached.
- Suggestions for other venues: Lyme Regis, Tenby, Abersoch.
- Consideration of moving away from August Bank Holiday to avoid clashes (e.g., Reading Festival).
- Sharon and Kirsten to coordinate inquiries and report back.
