

ISC Decision – request no3 2026 Bramwell McLaughlin

Request

Jasper Bramwell and Lucas McLaughlin are requesting a discretionary place for both the World Championships and Junior Europeans teams.

At the RYA Youth nationals on the opening day, Lucas suffered a blow to the head from the boom during race 2. This was subsequently confirmed by medical practitioners as a concussion. The RYA head injury policy dictated that they withdraw him from further racing. At the time after two races, Jasper and Lucas were in second place overall. Jasper elected to compete for the rest of the week as a crew with Jessica Skelding.

Lucas and Jasper have completed the following selector events:

- (1) Q1 Winter Championships – 7/8 February 2026, Draycote Water (13th overall)
- (2) Q2 Inland Championships – 21/22 March 2026, Rutland Sailing Club - Only 2 races sailed during event – event not valid. (8th overall)

Decision

Injury prevented Jasper and Lucas from completing Q3. Their results in Q1, Q2 and the first 2 races of Q3 and trajectory demonstrate that in all probability they would have finished high enough in the Ranking list to qualify for both the Worlds and Junior Euros team. The ISC have agreed to award Jasper and Lucas a discretionary place for both teams.
